Thank you for your interest in applying for a position at Hunter Christian School. This guide is provided to assist both teaching and non-teaching staff in making application for employment at our school. It is a guide only and you are free to add additional information. There are no separate application forms required.

Application format options

Applicants are encouraged to demonstrate their communication skills and have the following options in how they present their application;

- **Video application:** a short video (no more than 3 minutes) introducing yourself (as per *Letter of Introduction*) and your approach to faith and teaching / Christian Schooling (as per *Supporting Statements*). A Letter of Introduction with instructions to access the video, Resume and Supporting Documentation should still be provided in writing (via email).
- **Online digital resume:** an online Resume or Curriculum Vitae, with Supporting Statements is acceptable. A Letter of Introduction with instructions to access the online material and Supporting Documentation should still be provided in writing (via email).
- **Written application:** via email as per the guide below.
- **Portfolio of past work:** is an additional option that may be presented online or presented in person (for those who gain an interview).

1. Letter of Introduction

Please provide a letter of introduction with your application that includes the following information:

1. Your full name, residential address and contact information – listed on form attached
2. Details of the position applied for
3. Your reasons for applying
4. Addressed to the Principal with the subject "Confidential"

2. Resume / Curriculum Vitae

Please provide a resume that includes the following information

5. Teaching and / or other relevant qualifications, including;
 - a. Institution
 - b. Fields of study
 - c. Year completed
6. NESA Teaching accreditation number and status (for teaching positions)

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7. Working with Children Clearance number
8. Date of birth (required to verify WWCC clearance)
9. Citizenship / residency / visa status – (if not an Australian resident further details required)
10. Formal evidence of Double Vaccination Status (pdf format from mygov or MedicarePlus)
11. Past employment and experience
 - a. Position / title
 - b. School / employer
 - c. Grades and/or subjects taught (for teachers) / or role and responsibilities
 - d. Full time, part time or casual status for each year taught (for teachers)
12. Details of other relevant employment or volunteer work
13. Details of other relevant skills or experience
14. Details of church attended, and any Christian ministries engaged in
15. Phone referee contact details
 - a. A current or former Church Minister for a church you attended
 - b. A current or former School Principal (for teachers) or employer you worked under
 - c. At least one other referee to your character and/or professional practice

3. Supporting Documentation

 - b. Strategies to maximise student learning
 - c. Strategies to develop student character and faith
 - d. Developing oneself and one's colleagues as educators
 - e. Creating healthy school culture and community

EMPLOYMENT COLLECTION NOTICE

As an applicant for employment you need to be aware of the need for our school to comply with the National Privacy Principles which were enacted at the end of 2001. The school has developed a detailed policy (Hunter Christian School Privacy Policy) to ensure it complies with these principles. 2. If you provide us with personal information, for example your name and address or information contained on your resume, we will collect the information in order to assess your application.
3. You agree that we may store this information for the purpose of the interview process only after which times it will be destroyed within two months unless it is further required for your employment.
4. You may seek access to your personal information that we hold about you if you are unsuccessful for the position. However, there will be occasions when access is denied. Such occasions would include where access would have an unreasonable impact on the privacy of others.
5. We will not disclose this information to a third party without your consent.
6. We are required to conduct a criminal record check and collect information regarding whether you are or have been the subject of an AVO and certain criminal offences under Child Protection laws.
7. If you provide us with the personal information of others, we encourage you to inform them that you are disclosing that information to the School and why, that they can access that information if they wish, that the school does not usually disclose the information to third parties and that we may store their information for up to two months unless retained for the purpose of further employment.

HUNTER CHRISTIAN SCHOOL STATEMENT OF FAITH
